## Big Rules... For Hosting and Sending Students

---

### THE BIG RULES OF AFS INTERNATIONAL

#### NO DRUGS

- AFS students who use or possess any illegal drugs will be sent home immediately. This includes marijuana.
- If an AFS student is in a situation where illegal drugs are being used or possessed, AFS may send the student home even if he/she is not personally using drugs.

#### NO DRIVING

- Any AFS student found to be driving any type of motorized vehicle will be sent home immediately. This includes cars, trucks, motorcycles, tractors, mopeds or anything with an engine.

#### NO HITCH HIKING

- Any AFS student caught hitch hiking will be sent home immediately.

### ADDITIONAL RULE FOR HOSTED STUDENTS

#### NO ALCOHOL

- The legal drinking age for alcohol in the State of Washington is 21 years old.
- No Alcohol is to be consumed by any student under the age of 21.
- If an AFS student is arrested for a MIP (minor in possession) or MIC (minor in consumption), the student will be sent home immediately.

**Any AFS student who breaks any of these 3 rules will be sent home within 2 to 5 days of the incident. No exception.**
